Treatment: Size = Importance

- Headline
 - -Subhead
 - Supporting info
 - –See how it gets smaller?
 - »Size helps ORGANIZE and give visual clues to reader

Masthead/Banner

- The title of what we're looking at
- Special style, too!

Headline

 Focuses audience on what to expect in this document



Subhead

- Smaller headline starts to break down info, organize it for us
- Might have multiple "subhead" styles in a document






Small text organized in columns and sections

Treatment: Effects

- Commonly used:

 - Italic
 - <u>Underline</u>
 - ALL CAPS
 - Outline

- Online design often relies more on tables, grids, and other organizers to direct the viewer




What did you notice first?

Position: On page



- We tend to "read" from top left
 - To the right
 - And down
- We skim information quickly
 - Then go back and re-examine the info if it interests us

 - Stands alone





Position: Alignment



- Centered
 - On page
 - Or in section

Position: Alignment



- Left or right
 - Left aligned is most often used
 - Easiest to read

Position: Alignment

- Custom
 - Vertical
 - At an angle
 - Along a line or shape
